

敬啟者：

教育局於 3 月 26 日宣布全港幼稚園及中小學（包括特殊學校）在學校復活節假期後的面授課堂安排。在學校復活節假期後，按校本需要安排更多學生回校，並增加至以不多於全校人數三分二為限，上課時間仍以半天為限。現由 4 月 12 日起，學校將採取新安排，每天讓更多學生回校上課及治療，有關的應變措施如下：

1. **安排每天約十班學生回校上課及治療**，各班學生回校日期詳見下表：

2. **學校恆常每天清潔校舍及校車，並將於復活節假期內使用 Germagic 防疫殺菌塗層服務。**另學校已促請全校教職員加強衛生防疫措施，確保個人及學校環境衛生。此外，學校也要求所有服務學生的員工每天回校前量度體溫。任何教職員如有發燒，均不可回校。
3. **若家長對回校面授課堂有所顧慮，可考慮讓子女留在家中**，學校會彈性處理學生告假事宜，並為有關學生提供適切支援。
4. 學生於上述回校日子的**上學時間為上午 9:00，放學時間為下午 12:20**，上落校車時間將容後個別通知家長。
5. 2020 年 4 月 1 日(星期四)至 4 月 10 日(星期六)為復活節及清明節假期。
6. **原定於 4 月 29 日的學校旅行將會取消，當天如常上課；另於 4 月 30 日改為舉行校本活動**，當天回校班別會於校內進行活動，非回校班別則會透過網上實時形式 ZOOM 進行活動，詳情將稍後由班主任/活動負責人通知家長。
7. **測驗月已順延至 4 月 12 日至 4 月 30 日**，因應最新的回校日子安排，部分測驗日期或有更新，請留意班主任通知及稍後經通訊軟件發出的「**測驗時間及範圍**」修訂版，請家長提醒子女勤加溫習。
8. 由於學校正進行改建工程，將須封閉停車場，由 4 月 1 日起，學校將暫停設置訪客車位，亦請**駕車家長避免駛入校園上落，直至工程完畢**。如有特別情況，請聯絡校務處跟進。
9. 因應疫情的特殊情況，以及考慮現時社會整體經濟環境，經法團校董會批核，**豁免 2020 年 12 月、2021 年 1 月及 2 月的校車收費**。

10. 「四月份特別事項」的通告將取消發出，所須報告內容已於本通告列載。
11. 要讓學生在清潔和安全的環境下學習，家長及同學們的合作至為重要。我們懇請家長除了加強家居衛生外，還嚴格落實下列措施：
- 11.1 留意子女的健康狀況，如出現病徵，**尤其發燒、呼吸道感染徵狀、突然喪失味覺或嗅覺等，切勿上學**，並立即求醫，亦可按情況進行檢測；
- 11.2 於回校日上學前為子女**量度體溫**，並填寫由本校提供的「量度體溫記錄表」(表格 A)，簽署後由學生帶回學校；
- 11.3 為防感染，請促請學生每天上學時（包括乘坐校車或其他交通工具）**必須戴上口罩**，並為學生**帶備5個口罩、紙巾和水樽**等回校使用。
- 11.4 為提高教職員對學生健康情況的警覺性，請家長填寫「**學生外遊及健康狀況申報表**」(表格 B)，提供各項資料。如有特別情況，**如確診2019冠狀病毒病、被列為密切接觸者、須進行強制檢測、14日內曾外遊(經回港易計劃返港除外)等**，學生**切勿上學，以保障師生健康**。班主任亦會再次致電家長，收集有關上述資料，以便學校更有效採取各項防疫工作。
- 11.5 若學生回校後身體不適，如出現發燒、流感等徵狀，學校會即時採取隔離措施，並請家長到校接回子女，並盡快帶子女求醫。
12. **其他不用回校的班級將繼續進行網上學習**，網上實時課堂(Zoom)時間表依據下學期半日上學的上課時間表，家長請按手冊上張貼的時間表所列的時間和科目，與學生進行網上實時的早會、早操、班務及課堂(恆班中五組則依據下學期網上實時教學時間表上課)。請沿用九月份網上實時課堂的Zoom帳戶及密碼。
13. 治療部將繼續透過不同形式支援非回校學生的治療訓練，並會個別聯絡家長。
14. 老師會繼續把課業和學習資源以電郵或上載電子學習平台的方式發送給同學，並於**學生回校日派發課業及各樣學習資源**。未能回校面授課堂的學生，校務處將個別聯絡家長派送課業的形式和安排。
15. 學校於維持暫停面授課堂期間仍會保持校舍開放，以照顧有需要返校的學生，並為家長提供適切的支援，如有任何特別情況，家長可盡早聯絡學校。

學校會按衛生防護中心的指示，加強校內的清潔及消毒工作，並採取各項衛生防護措施，以保障師生健康。學校亦促請家長依照衛生防護中心的健康指引，為預防2019冠狀病毒病採取合適的預防措施，詳情請瀏覽 <http://www.chp.gov.hk>。家長應避免帶子女前往人多擠逼、空氣流通欠佳的地方，並讓子女保持均衡飲食、恆常運動及充足休息以增強免疫力。

Prevention of Coronavirus Disease 2019 Class arrangements after Easter holidays

The EDB, after taking into account the latest developments of the epidemic, the advice of health experts and the preparedness of schools, has decided that all KGs and primary and secondary schools (including special schools) will be allowed to **arrange for more students to return to campuses on a half-day basis** in accordance with school-based circumstances after the schools' Easter holidays, **with the number of students capped at two-thirds of the schools' total number of students. Starting from 12 April, the school will adopt new arrangements to allow more students to return to school for lessons and treatment every day. The relevant contingency measures are as follows:**

1. **The school will arrange about ten classes of students to return to school every day for lessons and therapy.** Please refer to the following table for the dates of face-to-face classes for different classes:

2. **Our school has thoroughly cleaned and disinfected the school premises and school buses.** We have urged all staff members to step up precautionary measures to maintain personal hygiene and environmental hygiene of the school. Besides, we will also request all the staff who have contacts with our students to take their temperature before going to school. If they have fever, they must not return to school.
3. **If parents have concerns about resuming face-to-face classes, they can consider leaving their children at home.** The school will handle student absence flexibly and provide appropriate support to the students whenever necessary.
4. **The school time for students on the above dates of face-to-face classes is 9:00 am to 12:20 pm.** Parents will be notified individually of the school bus time schedule later.
5. No school for Easter Holiday and Ching Ming Festival, which starts from 1 April, 2021 (Thursday) to 10 April, 2021 (Saturday).
6. **The School Picnic originally scheduled on 29 April, 2021 will be cancelled and become a normal school day. School-based activity day will be held on 30 April, 2021.** Classes that return to school on that day will have activities in school. Classes that are not in school on that day will conduct activities through the online real-time ZOOM. Parents will be notified of the details later by the class teacher/ the activity person-in-charge.
7. **The Test Period will be rescheduled to 12 April to 30 April.** In accordance with the latest face-to-face classes arrangement, some test dates may be updated. **Parents will be notified of the revised "test date and syllabus" by the class teacher.** Please remind students to do revision.
8. As the school is carrying out the Improvement Project of the school campus, the car park will be closed starting from 1 April, 2021. The school will suspend all visitor parking spaces. **Parents are also advised not to drive onto the campus for neither pick-ups nor drop offs until the completion of the project.** For individual cases, please contact the school office to follow-up.
9. In response to the special circumstances of the epidemic and considering the overall economic environment of the current situation, approved by the IMC, **the school bus fees for December 2020, January and February 2021 will be exempted.**
10. **The notice of "April Special Announcements" will not be issued. Those need to be announced are listed in this notice already.**

11. Cooperation from parents and students is important for us to maintain a clean and safe environment. We call on your support to step up environmental hygiene in the household, and, on top of that, implement the following measures strictly:
 - 11.1 Pay attention to the health condition of your child. ***He/She should stay away from school and see a doctor immediately if symptom, especially fever, respiratory infection symptoms, sudden loss of taste or smell, etc. are detected.***
 - 11.2 ***Take your child's temperature before he/ she goes to school.*** Fill in the record sheet (Proforma A), sign your name on it and return the completed sheet.
 - 11.3 To prevent infection, please ask your child to ***wear a mask*** (also applicable when taking school buses or other transportations) and ***bring 5 masks, tissue and water bottle to school.***
 - 11.4 To keep teachers' informed of the health condition of students, please complete Proforma B to provide the necessary information such as ***the current health status, travel history in the past 14 days, confirmed infection of COVID-19, confirmed cases of residential building, compulsory testing of COVID-19 etc.*** Students should not go to school in case of the above situation. Moreover, the school will again collect information by phone call from the class teacher. The school can then take the precautionary measures more effectively.
 - 11.5 If the student feels unwell after returning to school, such as fever, flu and other symptoms, the school will immediately take isolation measures, and parents are requested to pick up their children from school and take them to see a doctor as soon as possible.
12. ***All the classes that need not go to school for face-to-face classes will continue online learning.*** The online real-time class timetable (Zoom lessons) will be the same as the timetable of the half-day schooling. Parents should refer to the timetable in the school handbook and having the Zoom morning assembly, morning exercise, class teacher period and lessons according to the time and subject shown on that timetable. (For Class Hang S5, please refer to the Zoom real-time class timetable.) Please use the Zoom ID and password of those used in September Zoom lessons.
13. The Therapy Departments will continue to support students' treatment training in different forms, and will contact parents individually.
14. Teachers will send homework and learning resources to students by email or upload to the e-learning platform. ***Homework and other learning materials will also be distributed to students on the day when they go to school for face-to-face classes. For students who will not go to school, the school office will contact their parents individually for the arrangement of distributing the homework and materials.***
15. During the suspension of face-to-face classes, the school will keep our premise open to take care of those students in need and to provide support to parents whenever necessary.

The school has strengthened disinfection and cleaning of the school campus and strictly observe all the health protection measures in accordance with the instruction from the Department of Health, so as to safeguard the health and well-being of teachers and students. We would like to urge parents to put in place appropriate preventive measures to guard against the spread of COVID-19, based on the health advice from CHP. For details, please refer to <http://www.chp.gov.hk>. Parents should avoid taking their children to crowded places with poor ventilation. Students should maintain a balanced diet, exercise regularly, and take adequate rest in order to strengthen their immunity.
